

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is construction, renovation and demolition waste?

CRD waste ranges from cut ends of 2×4's to brick to pipes. Think about what happens when a house is built, renovated or taken down – all that material is considered construction waste and most of it can be recovered.

What materials can I bring?

Because the Tomlinson Waste Recovery Centre also has a Materials Recycling Facility (MRF), a Transfer Station in addition to the Construction and Demolition (C&D) Facility we can accept almost all solid non-hazardous waste.

Do I need to sort my materials before I come to the Centre?

No! You can bring it as is and our team will sort the material.

Where do I go when I get there?

Once onsite, follow signs to the scale and our team will guide you from there.

Do you offer bin/dumpster rental services?

I go to the Trail Road Dump now, why use this Centre?

Traditional dumps or landfills bury waste. The Tomlinson Waste Recovery Centre diverts material from landfills that still has a use and does not need to be buried. This extends the life of landfill assets and protects our natural resources.
